Thank you again for the positive approach that we have seen with the introduction of our online learning program at the College. Our staff have been delighted with the very positive engagement of students from Pre-K right through to Year Twelve.

As you will no doubt be aware, we are marking rolls through student engagement with their online learning. Roll marking is a requirement even though learning is taking place in a flexible mode. The State Government has an expectation of all schools to maintain attendance records and it is also important for our staff to also be aware that all of our students are engaging with their learning program from a wellbeing perspective.

I have been visiting our staff throughout the day and all have been delighted with the positive engagement of students.

As has been previously communicated, there is provision at the College for students who are not able to be cared for at home. These students are undertaking the same online program that is provided for students off site and they are being supervised by Teacher's Aides and Support Staff rather than class teachers.

With further announcements being made from our Prime Minister about the importance of social distancing, we request that as any parents are dropping their children off at the College, that they move on quickly in order to honour this directive. Our government is very serious about managing the spread of COVID-19 and it is important that all community members honour the directions of our health authorities. Again, in the afternoon, we also ask that parents do not gather together for collection of students.
