COVID-19 Update

Dear RHAC Community,

As you would be aware, the NSW Government has made an announcement today that Public Schools will return full-time from next week (Monday 25th May).

While we have been satisfied with the transition process to date, we still have some concerns around the sudden move to full time schooling for all students from next week. These concerns include transport and also managing social distancing as much as possible on site. We are also aware of a recent and very local case of COVID-19 that may have impacted on some members of our community and feel that it is best to exercise caution.

The College has made the decision to continue with our plan for Week 5 as below and then to return to full time attendance from the beginning of Week 6 (Monday 1st June).

The College will be continuing with our additional cleaning routines as per our transition plans. Additionally, parents are not to leave their vehicles as they drop off and pick up their children until notified otherwise.
