Dear Parents and Carers,

On Friday 23rd July, Blacktown Local Council area was added to the list of LGA's with tightened restrictions. Rouse Hill Anglican College sits within this Local Government area. Some of our staff and students also reside in this LGA.

Most of the restrictions have remained the same in regard to the Stay-at-Home order mandated on the 18th July. The main change is that early childhood education has now been added to the Stay-at-Home order to further reduce movement and interaction within the community, and hence limit the possibility of the spread of COVID-19. Parents are advised that they must keep their children in Pre-K at home unless they are emergency, healthcare or authorised workers and have no other option.

It is important that we work within the spirit of the public health order and do our part in reducing the spread of this highly contagious Delta variant. We implore parents of all year groups, Pre-K to Year Twelve, to keep their children at home unless there are absolutely no other options. The College will remain open but only with the minimum of staff for supervision of students, whose parents are working in emergency, health care and authorised work.

PRE-K REMOTE LEARNING

- Monday 26th July - Pre-K staff will prepare and organise appropriate online resources to supplement the matrices which will be uploaded to Seesaw on Monday. Pre-K students are to be kept at home, except children of emergency, healthcare and authorised workers.
- Tuesday 27th July - Remote learning will commence for Pre-K, 3 Day students.
- Thursday 29th July – Remote learning will commence for Pre-K, 2 Day students.

We pray that these measures will help to reduce the spread of COVID-19 in our community and LGA.
