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Dear Parents,

The NSW Government has confirmed that current lockdown restrictions will continue until at least the end of July. As such, the College will continue to provide remote learning for students. Supervision onsite will be provided for families who are not able to keep their children at home, particularly those involved in health, education, emergency or other essential services.

### Locker Access

Some students have indicated they need to collect books or materials from their lockers. If your child requires this, they may do so on **Friday 16<sup>th</sup>, Monday 19<sup>th</sup> or Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> July** at the time indicated in the table below:

We ask that students abide by the following directives:

- Parents are to remain in their cars
- Students need to wear a mask and check in with the Services NSW QR Code or with the supervising teacher.
- Students should ensure they collect the materials promptly and avoid interaction with others.

Students should not visit the College at all if they are unwell or have a reason to be isolating.

### Changes to Curriculum and Assessment requirements

Each Senior School Faculty is reviewing the impact of the extended lockdown on the learning sequence and upcoming assessments. Any changes to assessments will be communicated by the Head of Department or class teacher.

Mr Johnston, Director of Curriculum, and Mr Watt, Year Twelve Advisor, will provide specific updates for Year Twelve should any new information become available. Year Twelve students are reminded that they are able to attend the College to complete



any aspects of their learning that cannot be completed at home, particularly major project work. Students should liaise with their teacher to arrange a mutually convenient time to meet.

### **Managing Remote Learning**

Student participation in remote learning will be monitored daily through Canvas. Should your child miss their morning Canvas check in, please contact Student Reception. If your child is unwell and will not be engaging in remote learning for the day, please advise [absent@rhac.nsw.edu.au](mailto:absent@rhac.nsw.edu.au).

If your child is having troubling accessing the remote learning materials or completing set tasks, they are encouraged to contact their class teacher. Teachers will regularly monitor completion of remote learning activities and will let you know if they become concerned that your child is either not completing tasks or is not completing them to a satisfactory standard.
